JUDAH TRIBE ROCKS BROOKLYN

Brooklyn, NY:

Over 6,000 fans turned out on Saturday (Aug. 2) for Judah Tribe's performance at the Reggae Retro/Revival Reggae Sundays dance party and concert. The performance was part of the Brooklyn Museum's Target 1st Saturdays monthly event. Judah Tribe thrilled the crowd with its special blend of soul reggae music.

One of the highlights of the night came when guitarist Les Paultre, father-in-law of the late Sean Bell, electrified the crowd on the song Judgment.

The soon to be released single, Judgment, has become a hot topic of debate in many circles because of its fiery lyrics. Fans were also treated to songs like Sometimes Love, Go Tell It and Sleepwalker, receiving a special preview of the band's upcoming debut album New Day Dawnin. From the United Nations and NJ Performing Arts Center to S.O.Bs, the Danny Simmons Corridor Gallery and now the Brooklyn Museum, Judah Tribe has been mesmerizing fans everywhere.

According to museum officials, the dance party and concert was one of their largest shows to date. Target 1st Saturdays at the Brooklyn Museum has been ongoing for over 10 years. "It was one of the best shows I've

seen," said one fan. DJ Silence of Pointblank Sound alongside hype man Guidance also kept the crowd dancing with the sweet sounds of reggae music.

With a style that is reminiscent of the golden age of reggae music, Judah Tribe has honed its unique blend of soul reggae. From the smooth love song Sometimes Love to the highly political Sleepwalker Judah Tribe has captured the imagination of its fans. Comparisons to legends such as Steel Pulse, Peter Tosh and Bob Marley are not uncommon.

After their initial meeting in 2005, these talented musicians would find a common mission and goal. As a result of a unique collaboration, Judah Tribe was born. With members stemming from Cameron, Africa, Jamaica, France, Haiti and the USA, Judah Tribe has developed a truly international following.

Judah Tribe is led by accomplished singer/songwriter/guitarist Josh David whom has played bass guitar for many renown artists including Stevie Wonder, Common and Q-Tip. Together with music director and keyboardist Eric "The General" Toussaint, Josh David has crafted a unique sound that is stirring lots of conversation.
